EPTL filers are registered under the Estates, Powers & Trusts Law ("EPTL") because they hold assets and/or conduct activites for charitable purposes in NY.

DUAL filers are registered under both 7A and EPTL.

EXEMPT filers have registered with the NY Charities Bureau and meet conditions in **Schedule E - Registration Exemption for Charitable Organizations.** These organizations are not required to file annual financial reports but may do so voluntarily.

Where do I find my organization's NET WORTH?

NET WORTH for fee purposes is calculated on:

- IRS From 990 Part I, line 22
- IRS Form 990 EZ Part I line 21
